**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI,
RENAMING THE RURAL INTERNET ACCESS COMMITTEE AS THE
INTERNET ACCESS COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, on May 29, 2007, the Planning/Economic Development/Parks Committee presented a recommendation to the City Council to establish a committee to review options and make recommendations to the City Council to improve broadband internet access and speeds throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2007, the Mayor, with the consent of the City Council, appointed the first members of the Rural Internet Access Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council identified city-wide improvements to broadband internet access and speeds as its top strategic planning priority; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the City Council's stated priority, the City Council desires to clarify the purpose and goals of the committee tasked to study, analyze and develop recommendations to the City Council on the technology, methods, means, financing, and infrastructure necessary to provide improved broadband access and speeds throughout the entire City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That the Rural Internet Access Committee established by the appointment of the first members thereto on October 8, 2007, be and is heretofore to be renamed and known as the Internet Access Committee.

Section Two. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
